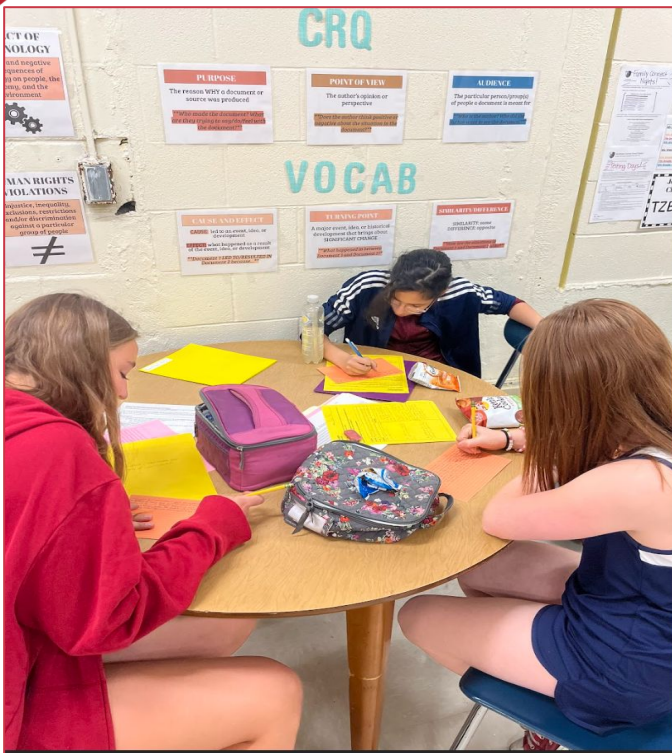
7th Grade Prep Academy

- Taught by our middle school teacher assistants Ms. Carpenter, Ms. Casale, and Mr. Dupius
- 10 sessions - March through June





7th Grade Prep Academy



Session	Lesson Topic
1	Introduction: Introducing the Program, Vocabulary, and Way of Thinking <i>(SAQ/LEQ/Context/Perspective)</i>
2	Thesis Week 1: Criteria <i>(Historically Defensible, Respond v. Restate, AP Line of Reasoning)</i>
3	Thesis Week 2: Practice <i>(Thesis Statements attached to LEQ)</i>
4	Evidence <i>(Evidence that Supports Your Claim)</i>
5	Culminating Activity: Introduction <i>(Schenck v. US Jury Simulation)</i>
6	Research Week 1 <i>(Student-Centered Research Pick Scenarios)</i>
7	Research Week 2 <i>(Student-Centered Research Write Opening Statements)</i>
8	Wrap-Up Research/Presentations <i>(Finish Up Research, Scenarios 1-2)</i>
9	Presentation <i>(Scenarios 3-4)</i>
10	Culminating Evaluation Activity <i>(LEQ - Evaluation Argument)</i>

Objective:

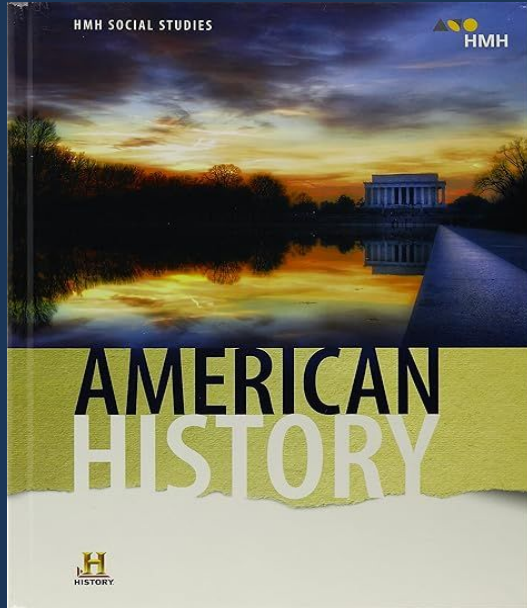
- Transition students from middle school to AP level work in one year

Instructional Shifts:

- Emphasis on argumentative writing aligned to AP level expectations
- Exposure to high school and college-level primary and secondary sources
- "Flipped classroom" approach similar to AP level courses
 - Preview more than review

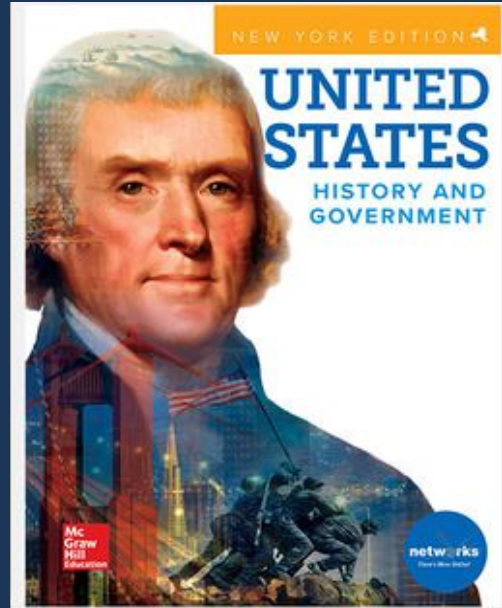

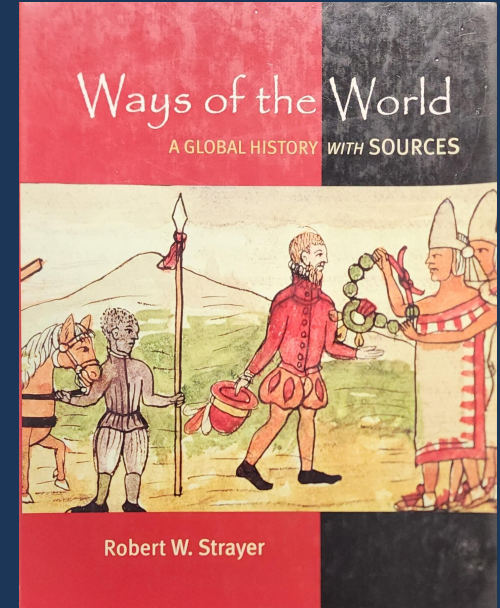

Sample Writing Prompts

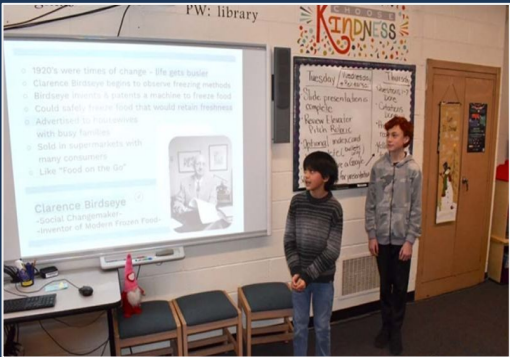
Social Studies 8: prompts aligned to Grade 10 Enduring Issues Essays

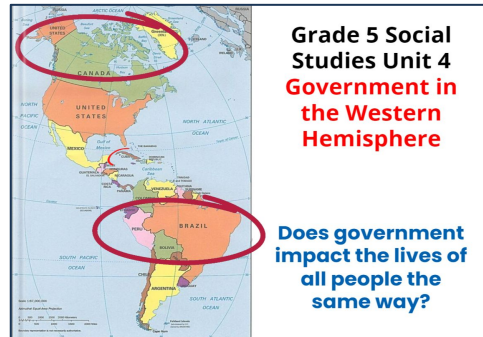
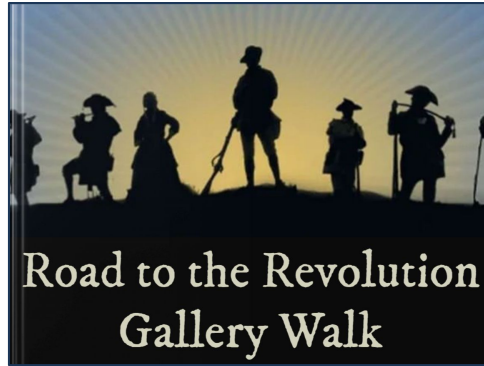

- Updating resources using Book Creator to:
- Increase excitement and motivation for learning social studies
 - Improve student engagement
 - Improve the quality of instructional tools
 - Further vertically align skillsets



Areas for Future Growth

1. Enhancing the full scope of elementary instruction using Book Creator
2. Improving data-driven instruction at the secondary level using DataMate Assessment Analysis System. Currently, DataMate is being used in a pilot form in a few of our classes
