

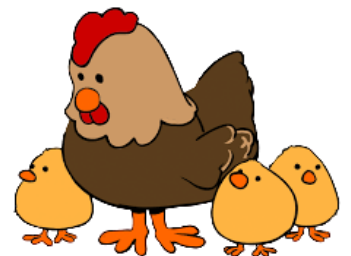


"Moo"ving into Kindergarten!

Here is a list of supplies your child will need for School.

Please follow the attached directions.

- 1 bottom pocket folder:
- 1 primary Marble Journal Notebook (MEADE) these have a space on the top for pictures.
- 2 boxes of Crayola 24 Count Crayons
- 1 Pair of Fiskar scissors 5"
- 6 JUMBO glue sticks
- 4 THIN black dry erase markers
- 1 small CLEAN sock
- 1 8 Ct. Box fine tip crayola washable markers
- 5 12 Ct. SHARPENED YELLOW TICONDEROGA #2 pencils
- 1 24 Ct. Crayola Twistable Crayons
- 2 boxes of SOFT tissues
- 2 boxes of baby wipes
- 1 box of Gallon Ziplock Bags (if your last name starts with A-M) ka
- 1 box of quart size Ziplock Bags (if your last name starts with N-Z)
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 4-Pack of LARGE PLAYDOH
- 2 Plastic Supply Boxes
- 1 pack glue dots



Directions:

On the FIRST DAY, please send: Your kindergartner with a SMILE, backpack, snack & lunch as well as the following supplies.

1. Supply box filled with... 3 sharpened pencils, one glue stick, crayons, scissors and 1 can of play-doh.
2. A recent photo of your child (3x5 or 4x6)
3. All 3 folders and your LMNOP Summer reading book.
4. Inside a LABELED ZIP-LOCK: Elmer's glue, Large Pink Erasers, 24 sharpened pencils (Yellow #2)
5. A change of clothes in a LABELED ZIP-LOCK Bag.
6. label the clothing as well and include socks & underwear.

Accidents happen!

On the **SECOND DAY**, please send:

1. Please send in the remaining supplies. Small items such as twistables, pencils, markers, paint, dry erase markers, thin magic markers, and a small clean sock, should be put into a large zip lock bag.
2. The Zip Lock Bags (either the quart or gallon depending on your last name)
3. Boxes of soft tissues and wipes.
