UNITY DAY




Mrs. Sellitto created a beautiful unity bulletin board using decorated hands and hearts that were customized by students and staff.

Be sure to join us for a spooky night, ghosts and goblins sure to bring you a fright! Lollipops, spiders, and food trucks galore, come to see what's in store!


