Departmental recommendation can be challenged.

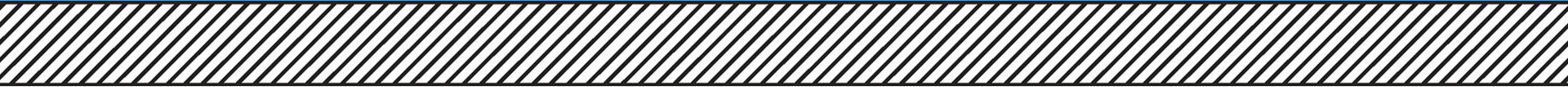


## Prerequisite & Co-requisite

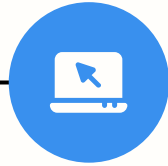
# SCHEDULING TIMELINE



## February 1st - 9th

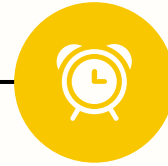
Parents will have access to the parent portal and the ability to view and change their child's elective classes until February 9th

\*After February 9th, contact your child's counselor with any scheduling concerns



## February 1st - 9th

Counselors will be taking 8th grade students into the computer lab to view course placements and elective choices



## March/April/ May

These months are devoted to building the master schedule based upon course placements, student requests, and fiscal constraints
