In small groups, the children acted out a scenario and the class identified what strategy each group was using to solve the conflict. The students have expanded their Conflict Resolution toolbox!

Over the course of the school year, Mrs. McGlone works in every K-5 classroom to teach lessons about a range of topics including the transition to middle school, goal setting, digital citizenship, becoming a good friend, being successful, having a positive attitude, self control and listening skills.

When you first start skating you will learn a two foot spin which is when you put your toe pick in the ice and use the other foot to spin around and gain speed the next spin you will learn is a one foot spin you can start it with a toe pick on the ice or you can start the more advanced way which is a backward crossover and them you use your other foot to step forward and gain speed. The next spin you will learn is a scratch spin and then a sit spin. The next spin is a camel spin and then a layback spin.

After a backspin, the first jump you will learn is a bunny hop. Here are some more advanced jumps you might learn: waltz jump, salchow, toe loop, half flip, flip, loop. half lutz, lutz, axel, double salchow and toe loops. Those are all of the jumps that people can complete in a single, double, triple, or quadruple!
