A. Updates

- In response to discussion at last meeting regarding timely approval of capital projects from the State Education Department, a letter was sent to Senator Flanagan and Assemblyman Fitzpatrick. A representative from Senator Flanagan's office called with a response, saying that additional inspectors are to supposed to be hired soon. If it happens this should alleviate some of the backlog of projects that need to be approved.
- As of today's date we have used four snow days. School will be in session on May 22nd and May 26th, no additional changes to the calendar are needed.
- All transportation requests for the 2015-2016 school year for private or parochial school students must be made by April 1, 2015 regardless of whether the request is for a first-time applicant or is a removal. If you are a first time applicant, you need to register your child with the Smithtown School District in order to be considered for transportation, receive textbooks and/or other educational services. Registration must occur in person and will take place at 26 New York Avenue until the April 1st deadline.
- Our DECA Chapters did very well at the New York State DECA Competition held in Rochester last week. There are 25 students going to the International DECA Competition in Orlando, FL next month.
- Students were inducted in to the New York State DECA Honor Society and the Chapters received New York State recognition.
