VI. COMMITTEE REPORTS –

Policy- Mr. Thode reported that a meeting was held on October 6th. Policies 1800- Gifts from the Public, 2270-School Attorney, 4326- Programs for English Language Learners will be presented for a first reading tonight. Several other policies are under review including Staff Complaints and Grievances, Health and Safety Committee, Attendance and School Admissions. The next meeting is scheduled for November 30.

Health and Safety- Ms. Plourde reported that a meeting was held on September 28th. Topics discussed included an update from the Facilities department which reported on completion of summer projects (boilers, roof and pothole repair), playground resurfacing, and acquisition of a generator. There was an update from the Security department on emergency management protocols and security cameras. The Health Office reported that glucagon training is ongoing for staff and volunteers, in consultation with the District’s medical director.

VII. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- **Updates** : Dr. Grossane reported that he attended the Long Island Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development and the Suffolk County School Superintendents meeting last Friday. Commissioner Elia was in attendance at both meetings and offered her impressions on Common Core and state assessments.
- **Cooling Towers:** Dr. Grossane followed up on the topic of the cooling towers and positive test results for the Legionella bacteria. New York State Department of Health required all buildings with cooling towers be tested as a result of the recent outbreak of Legionaries disease in the city. The cooling towers at High Schools East and West were taken offline and decontaminated. The cooling towers are maintained twice a month and as a result are in very good shape and clean.
- **Parent University:** Ms. Bradshaw reported that we are still waiting to finalize the date. The topics will be determined by parent and community responses to a survey(which is available on our website)outlining the Superintendent’s goals for the District. One of the topics will be creating resilient communities in response to substance abuse specifically heroin and prescription drug abuse.
