Meetings start at 8:00 P.M. and continue until all Agenda items have been considered. In addition, the Board may hold other Special Meetings and Committee Meetings. During any of the meetings, the Board may defer discussion of appropriate matters (as set forth in the Freedom of Information Act – Public Officers Law, Section 100) to Executive Session. These sessions are not open to the public. Board action on all items, however, is taken at sessions which are open to the public.

On the Thursday preceding the meeting date, each Board member receives a copy of the Agenda, together with supporting information, in order to have sufficient time to study background information and be able to make decisions on the basis of all available materials. 2. It shall be in order for members of the Board to ask questions of the speaker in order to clarify the discussion.
3. The President may terminate the right of any speaker to continue his/her address.
