Policy: Ms. Plourde reported that a meeting was held on Sept. 28<sup>th</sup>. Two policies are on tonight's agenda for a first reading. Policy 5152 Admission of Non-Resident students is being revised to reflect changes in the law. Policy 2251 Tributes is being revised to only allow for tributes and memorials for deceased persons. The accompanying regulations and exhibits have been revised as well.

Instructional Services- Ms. McEnroy reported that a meeting was held on October 6<sup>th</sup>. Tina Mangano, Director of English and Allyson Cronin, Instructional Coach presented ELA, K-12 Curriculum and the Instructional Coaching Model. Mr. Saidens commented that this was an impressive presentation of the past, present and future of the K-12 curriculum. Ms. McEnroy and Mr. Saidens thanked Ms. Mangano and Ms. McClellan the administration and the teachers for all their work.

Mr. Thode asked Ms. Bradshaw if she felt the use of too much technology is a concern along with not enough activity in the classrooms. Ms. Bradshaw explained that "screentime" and the importance of movement in the classrooms is always something that is discussed with administration and the wellness committee.

Audit: Mr. Alcure attended the Audit committee meeting this morning. The closeout of the audit for 2015-2016 fiscal year is complete and the district received an "unqualified opinion", which is the best rating you can get. There were some minor corrective actions the district is implementing going forward. Mr. Alcure thanked Mr. Tobin and his team for a job well done.
