Charge of the Committee

 Identify methods to further highlight our highest achieving students in order to make them more desirable to highly selective colleges and universities and develop recommendations for the BOE Policy Committee related to Policy #4741: Class Rankings.



- 1. Add Gold Cord with Distinction
 - a. Existing Honor: Gold Cord for students with 4.0 Weighted GPA
 - b. Added Honor: Gold Cord with Distinction for students with 4.4 Weighted GPA



- 1. Transcript and School Profile
 - a. After 6 semesters, add details regarding:
 - i. Gold Cord or Gold Cord with Distinction Candidacy
 - ii. Explanation of Criteria
 - iii. Percentage of previous class that earned each distinction



- 1. Honor Speaker
 - At the end of seven semesters, the GPA for the top seniors will be calculated and all students who are eligible for either the Gold Cord or the Gold Cord with Distinction will vote to select an Honor Speaker from the list of names of those who are eligible for the Gold Cord with Distinction.



- 1. Graduation Attire
 - a. Utilize one cap and gown color for each school (Red for HSE, Blue for HSW)
 - b. Allow for additional school approved adornments
 - New cord to represent Gold Cord with Distinction
 - ii. Various Medals, District and State level honor societies and seals, military commitments etc.
