Following the completion of Phase I projects, the district is moving forward with the next grouping of projects. All Phase II projects have been approved by the New York State Education Department. Once Phase II projects are finalized, Phase III will commence.

HVAC upgrades at Smithtown Elementary, including upgrades to the faculty toilets, are being publicly bid this October. Work to commence summer 2024.

A Focus On Facilities

In 2021, Smithtown Central School District voters approved a \$120 million bond proposal to fund important improvements, including building enhancements and safety upgrades.

The proposal was the district's first in 20 years and, since garnering community support two years ago, there have been several upgrades to the district's facilities that will positively impact our students' experience.

The bond funded installation of HVAC systems to improve fresh air intake for school buildings, replacement of windows and doors, and upgrades to fire alarm systems.

Some auditoriums will get new seats, lighting and sound systems. The bond also funded replacement of tracks and synthetic turf fields at both high schools, and installation of synthetic turf baseball and softball infields.

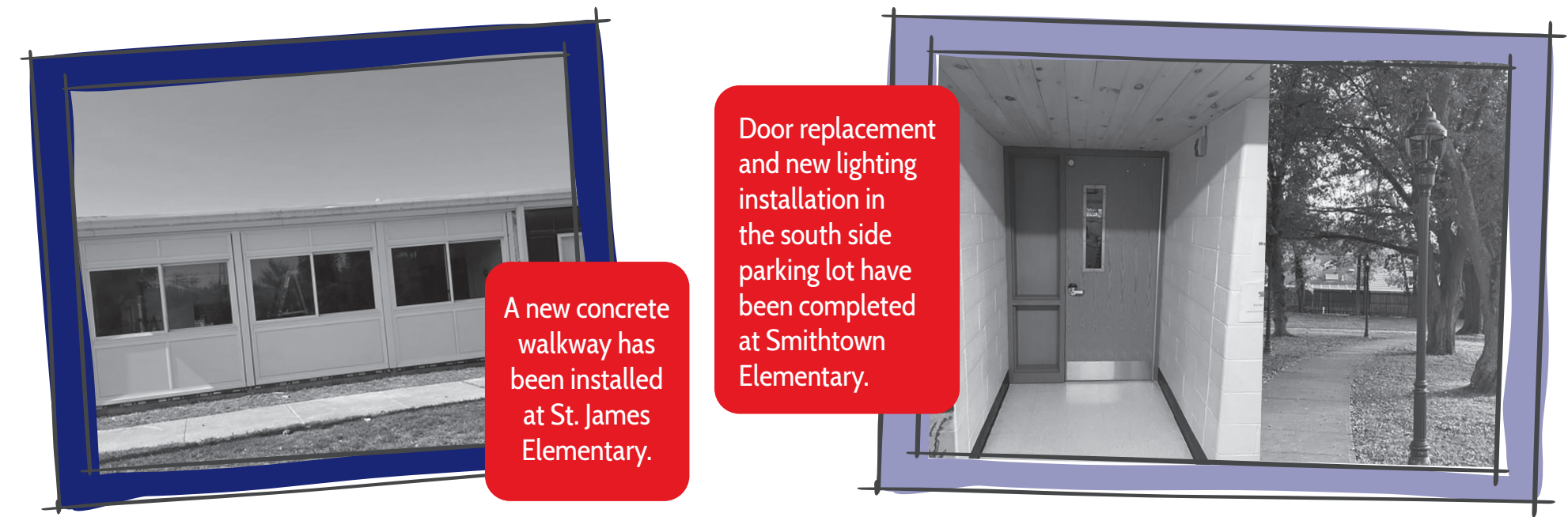
Many projects included in the bond have either recently wrapped up or are nearing their final stages of completion.

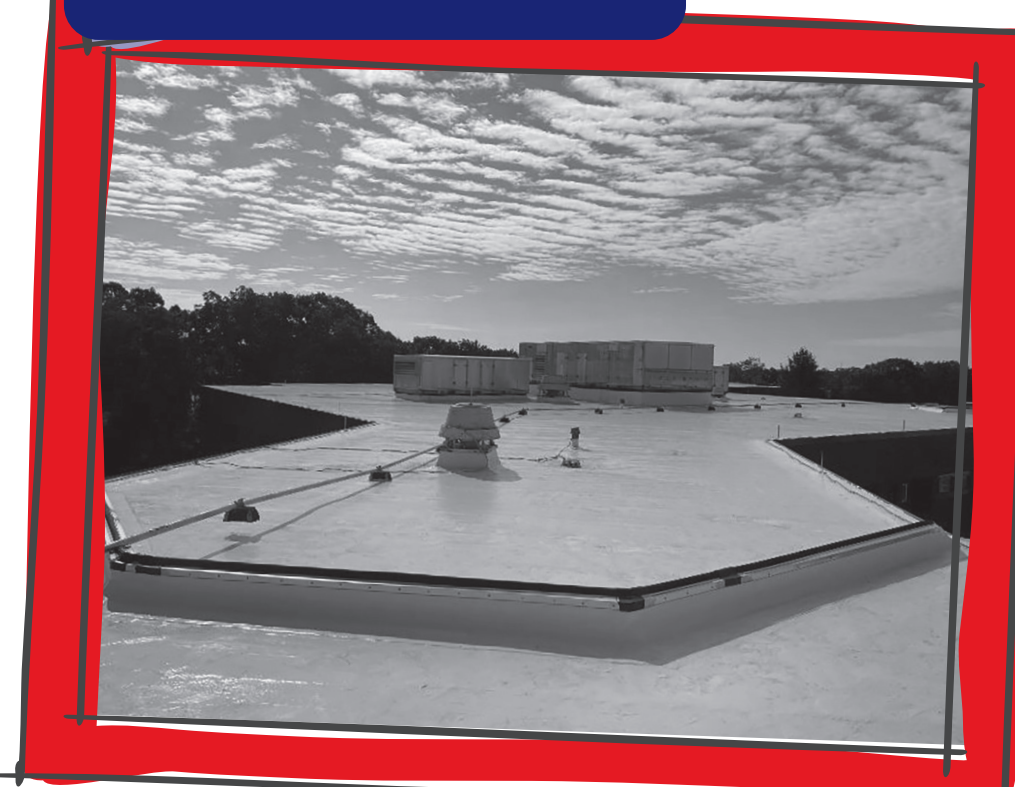
Synthetic turf fields and new tracks at both stadium fields at the high schools have been installed.
