

CONGRATULATIONS, CLASS OF 2024!

They turned their tassels, tossed their caps and celebrated as the newest graduates of Smithtown High School East and High School West. On a sunny Wednesday in June, more than 700 seniors comprised the Class of 2024 as they enjoyed a wonderful commencement ceremony.

At High School East, Superintendent of Schools Dr. Mark Secaur told the class, "I was very impressed with your level of pride, commitment and care to leave High School East a better place than how you found it. Rather than succumbing to early-onset senioritis, you sought to leave a legacy for future students. For that, you should be proud."

Principal Robert Rose addressed the graduating seniors, confident in their abilities no matter what paths they choose. "Whether that be heading off to college, the military, a trade school, entering the workforce or just taking a gap year to find your path, you will all find your way," he said.


