At High School West, Superintendent of Schools Dr. Mark Secaur told the class he had a different perspective at this year's graduation, due to the fact his oldest son is a new high school graduate himself.

"This is the end of my 28th year in public education, and as you can imagine, I have made many graduation speeches," Dr. Secaur told the class. "I want to express my deepest gratitude to each and every student here, those before you and the entire Smithtown community. Coming to Smithtown was one of the best things that ever happened to me."

Honor Speaker Rabia Chattha wanted her colleagues to know what she learned outside of the classroom was just as important as what she learned inside of it. But you are defined by your passion. People will remember you for how you made them feel."
