## IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS ENTERING GRADES 7 and 12 IN SEPTEMBER 2024

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 was amended to mandate students entering 7th grade to receive a single dose of meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine. This vaccine is to be administered to all adolescents entering 7th grade and a second dose administered again after the age of 16. Students entering the 12th grade are mandated to have (2) doses of the vaccine, or one dose if the first dose was given after the age of 16.

Please provide proof of immunization or a letter stating the student is to receive the vaccine as soon as possible to avoid your child being excluded from school.
