

**IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS ENTERING
GRADES 7 and 12 IN SEPTEMBER**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 was amended to mandate students entering 7th grade to receive a single dose of meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine. This vaccine is to be administered to all adolescents entering 7th grade and a second dose administered again after the age of 16. Students entering the 12th grade are mandated to have (2) doses of the vaccine, or one dose if the first dose was given after the age of 16.

Please provide proof of immunization within the first 14 calendar days of the start of the new school year to avoid your child's possible exclusion from school.

Please have your child's physician complete the form below and return it to the Health Office in the building your child will attend in 7th or 12th grade.
