As I am sure you are very well aware, we will have several days this week with temperatures well above normal. Our schools will remain open, but we will take all reasonable precautions to provide for a comfortable school environment for the students and our staff. With that in mind, the district will be limiting outdoor activities for the next few days. We will be sure to provide our students and staff with ample water breaks. We will also be maximizing the use of air conditioned spaces to the greatest extent possible.

Regarding air conditioning, the district is in the process of planning to update our heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems district-wide. The cost of this work is expected to be significant, so district-wide HVAC upgrades would only be feasible through a voter-approved bond issue. Prior to this, the district will utilize the services of engineers to perform electrical and mechanical capacity studies for all twelve instructional buildings in order to have a thorough understanding of the scope of the work involved, including the projected costs.
