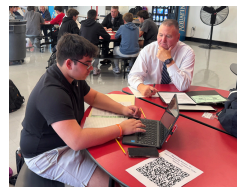
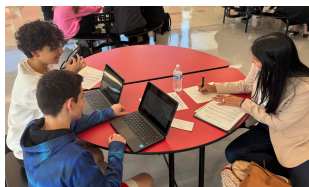


The 31<sup>st</sup> Business Olympics tradition in Smithtown included 255 students in over 53 teams who have to present their business and marketing proposals to a panel of judges in a preliminary competition and the finals all being held on November 20<sup>th</sup>. This year's theme was an extremely creative one...students had to develop a marketing plan for a DEFUNCT business in order bring in back to the current market.

In order to provide our students with an enhanced and enriched educational experience, the Smithtown IAB brought together over 20 industry members to work/mentor our teams in our annual Business Olympics Mentor Session. Students participated in 3 sessions which include: Technology "Tech" Session, The Marketing Session and finally the Mentoring session with our Smithtown IAB members. Each session lasted for 20 minutes where all teams rotate through session.

The feedback from our Smithtown IAB mentors was astounding! They all were so impressed with the high level of professionalism and their knowledge in business and marketing. This is just another example of how industry effectively with education through advisory boards.

The Business Olympics competition took place on November 20<sup>th</sup>, - preliminary rounds at HSE(8:30-12pm) and finals, HSW (5-9pm). 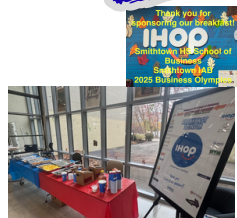

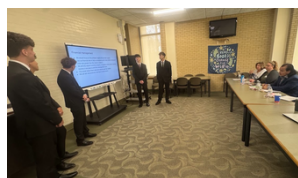
The future looks bright thanks to our SCSD business students! The Smithtown School of Business recently hosted its premiere event, the 31st annual Business Olympics, at High School West.

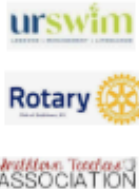

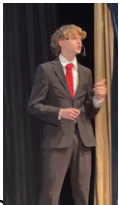

Smithtown Central School District took center stage on Nov. 4, as more than 250 educators from over 45 school districts on Long Island gathered for the LI Workforce Summit, an event dedicated to showcasing rewarding career paths in the skilled trades.

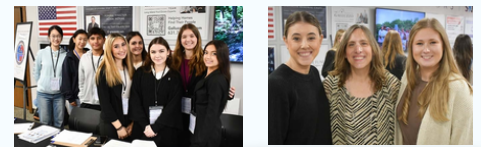
"It's a great day to reflect on what we choose to prioritize," said Smithtown Central School District Superintendent, Dr. Mark Secaur. "To make students aware. To open their eyes to the opportunities that are out there."

Held in Hauppauge, the summit highlighted the pipeline from "education-to-industry," citing hands-on professions as valuable, high-demand alternatives to traditional college routes, while connecting attendees with industry experts, training programs and local employers.

State Senator Mario Mattera spoke of the importance of the trades, while Smithtown IAB Executive Phil Como exclaimed that many students aren't aware of the growing job opportunities on Long Island.

"We have to get to know our students and keep them on the island...so we can grow on the island," Como said.

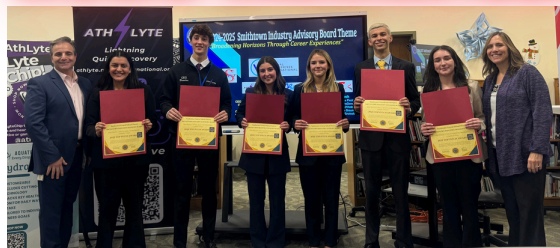
