# Scheduling Timeline

## *Starting January 26th*

- Counselors will meet with students individually to review recommendations, select their electives and all course requests
- If after the counselor and the student meet, you would like to make a change to a course request, please contact your child's counselor
- Students and families will have the opportunity to review and verify course requests in early March

- Review online course catalog
  - Is located Under Student and/or Parent Resources
- Familiarize yourself with the course descriptions for the core classes that have been recommended
- Choose multiple elective course requests
  - first choice, second choice and 2-4 alternate choices
- Students MUST be prepared with this information by January 26th to be ready for their individual meeting with their counselor
