Dear Parents,

Everyone at Mills Pond Elementary is excited to welcome you and your children to our School Family. Kindergarten serves as a part of the foundation of your child's education and a place for the wonderful school memories to begin. With that in mind, we plan to make your child's transition to kindergarten an exciting, happy memory.

In partnership with our PTA, we begin this journey by offering a Pre-Kindergarten Orientation Program for all children entering kindergarten in the fall of 2025. The program will consist of two sessions plus a bus ride. **Session 1 will be held on Monday, April 21 and Monday, April 28. Session 2 will be held on Friday, April 25 and Friday, May 2.** Children should wear **RED** on the first day (**April 21 or April 25**) and **BLUE** on the second day (**April 28 or May 2**). Each session will run from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. **During these sessions, you will be dropping off your child. If your child attends our UPK program, there is no need for you to come in on these dates.** Parents will have an opportunity to sign up for the session that best fits their child's schedule. **Unless you receive a call, the session you choose is the one your child will attend.** Additionally, the children will have the opportunity to ride the bus and participate in a physical education class on Wednesday, May 7 from 10:30-11:30 a.m. For the bus ride on May 7, all children should wear **YELLOW**. At this session, the parents will attend a workshop during the bus ride. Parents of UPK children should attend this session.

Sometime in May you will also be receiving information to register your child for a Kindergarten Screening appointment which will take place the week of June 9, 2025. **UPK parents do not have to register for this program as they will attend during their school day.** The screening process is a multi-step one in which your child will be asked to complete a series of tasks and activities as a means to assess readiness for kindergarten. This screening is important as it enables us to plan a quality educational program for your child. While your child is being screened you will be completing a questionnaire. **UPK children will bring the questionnaire home for parents to complete and return to the school as soon as possible.**

Once again, we are excited that your family will be joining our school family on this educational journey, and we look forward to meeting you during our Pre-K Orientation Program.

This program is designed to help your child become acquainted with their new school and to help prepare them to enter Kindergarten. Each week your child will stay for one hour (10:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.) visiting different areas of the school. Through classroom activities and socialization, we hope to make their arrival in September a positive and happy experience for all.
