- Student schedules are now available on the Parent Portal.
  - Extremely Important! Please remember to bring your <u>schedule</u>, <u>locker number & combination</u> with you on the first day of school. You will be reporting directly to your first period class, NOT a homeroom. <u>Students must follow the schedule they received.</u>
- New for 2023-24! We will be utilizing the Scholarchip platform this year to manage daily student check-in to the building and as an added measure of security for our campus. All students are now required to wear ID cards. New cards and lanyards will be given out in September. Questions regarding Scholarchip and/or ID Cards can be directed to any building administrator.
