Dear Parent or Guardian:

As the first semester winds down, I would like to inform you of this year's midterm testing and transportation schedule. New York State testing days will be Tuesday, January 23 through Friday, January 26, inclusively. Regular classes will resume on Monday, January 29, which will be the first day of the second semester. Monday, January 29 will be a "B" Day.

The testing schedule can be found HERE. Students will be informed by their teachers of specific test times and locations. We will be in state testing mode during these days. Students taking Regents Exams should keep backpacks and all bags at home. Access to student lockers will not be permitted during testing week. In an effort to further ensure test integrity, the New York State Education Department has enhanced its policy regarding cell phones and other electronic devices. Students are prohibited from bringing a phone, smartwatch or other electronic device into an exam location.

Any student found to be in possession of an electronic device during an exam may have their exam invalidated.

- All students should report to the auditorium upon arrival.
- Regular a.m. bus schedules are in effect for the morning exams (Session I and the AM Regents). Students for these sessions should be at their regular stops at the regular times. Students who do not have a Session I exam but only a Session II exam, should take this regular bus run and wait for their exam to begin in the high school auditorium. There will be special morning pickup and take home schedules, along with our regular 4:10 p.m. and 5:10 p.m. late buses each day. Each of these options will use regular late bus routes. The specifics of all transportation arrangements will be announced to the student body.

- Students using the 11:30 a.m. arrival should be waiting at their "Late Bus Stop" beginning at 10:45 a.m.
- Wilson Tech will be in session. Any Wilson Tech student who does not have a scheduled exam should plan on attending Wilson Tech at their regular time.
