Please try to have everything for the first day of school!

2 marble composition notebooks (100 sheets - wide ruled)

I nese should have lines on the entire page and should NOT be college rule
3 heavy Duty Plastic Pocket Folders in these solid colors:
☐ Yellow, Green, Blue,
4 dozen pencils: These must be SHARPENED before sending them to school.
4 LARGE glue sticks
Post its (3X3) 6 Pads - NO accordion post-its please
Small Supply Box (approximately 8.5" X 5.5" X 2.5")
1 box - 8 thin markers
2 box - colored pencils
2 yellow highlighters
8 thin dry erase markers - Black only
1 clean used sock - (used as an eraser for dry erase boards).
2 boxes - 24 crayons
1 box - 8 Crayons (Do NOT purchase if if Ms. Adams Class)
2 large pink erasers
1 small pencil sharpener with lid
1 pair scissors - preferably Fiskars
Headphones with a cord
2 large box tissues
1 box Gallon Ziploc bags (Do NOT purchase if in Mrs. Collett's class)
1 box quart size Ziploc Bags (do NOT purchase if in Mrs. Collett's class)
Baby Wipes

Label the colored folders and notebooks with a SHARPIE with your child's name.

For an easier transition the first day of school, we ask that you organize your child's supplies as follows:

- Sharpen all pencils, remove from original packaging and place in a large ziploc bag with your child's name on it.
- Remove the scissors, erasers, pencil sharpener, 1
 highlighter, 1 dry erase marker, sock, and 1 glue
 stick from packaging and place in the pencil box.
- Place remaining dry erase markers, highlighters, glue sticks, and Post Its in a ziplock with your child's name on it.
