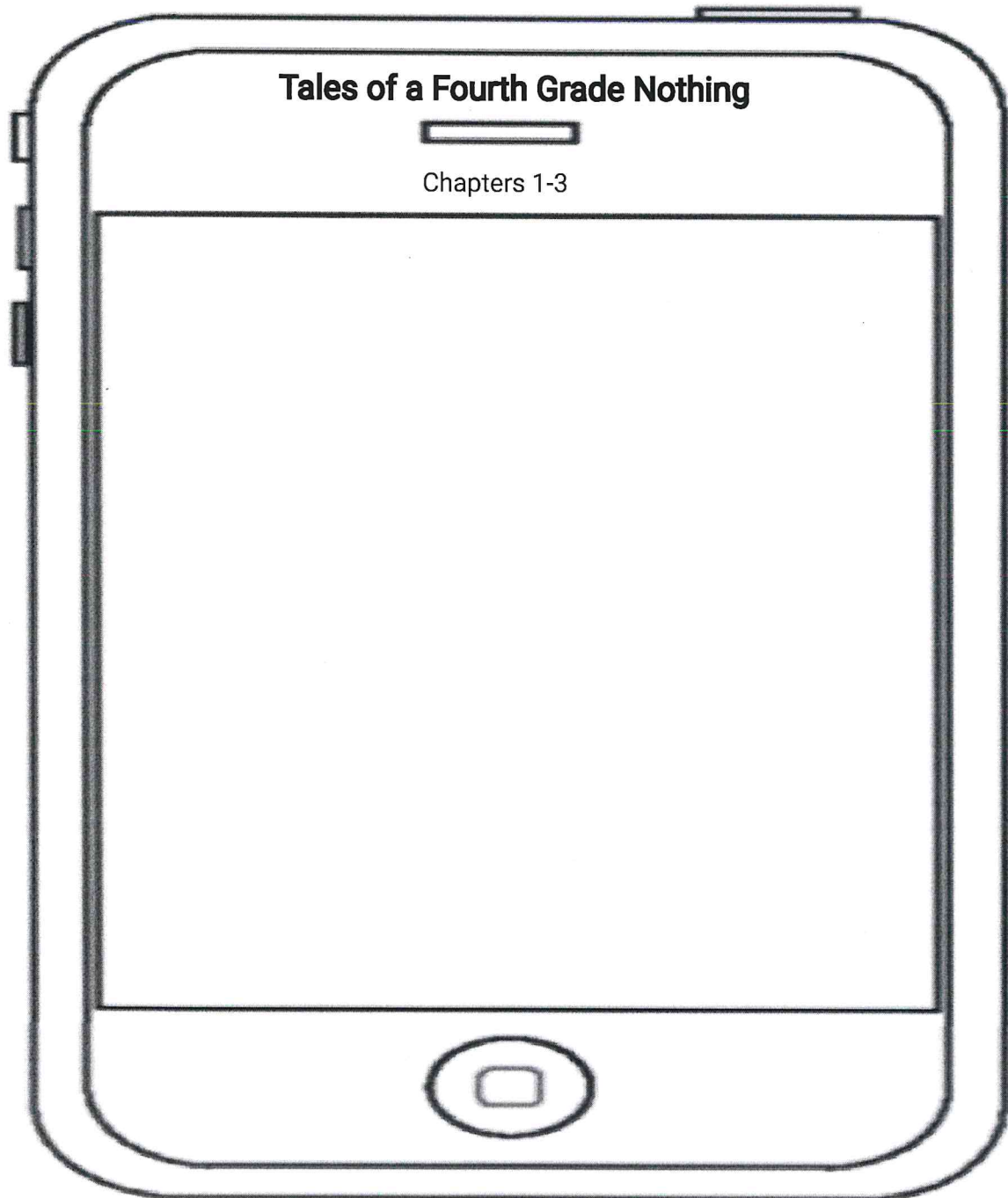

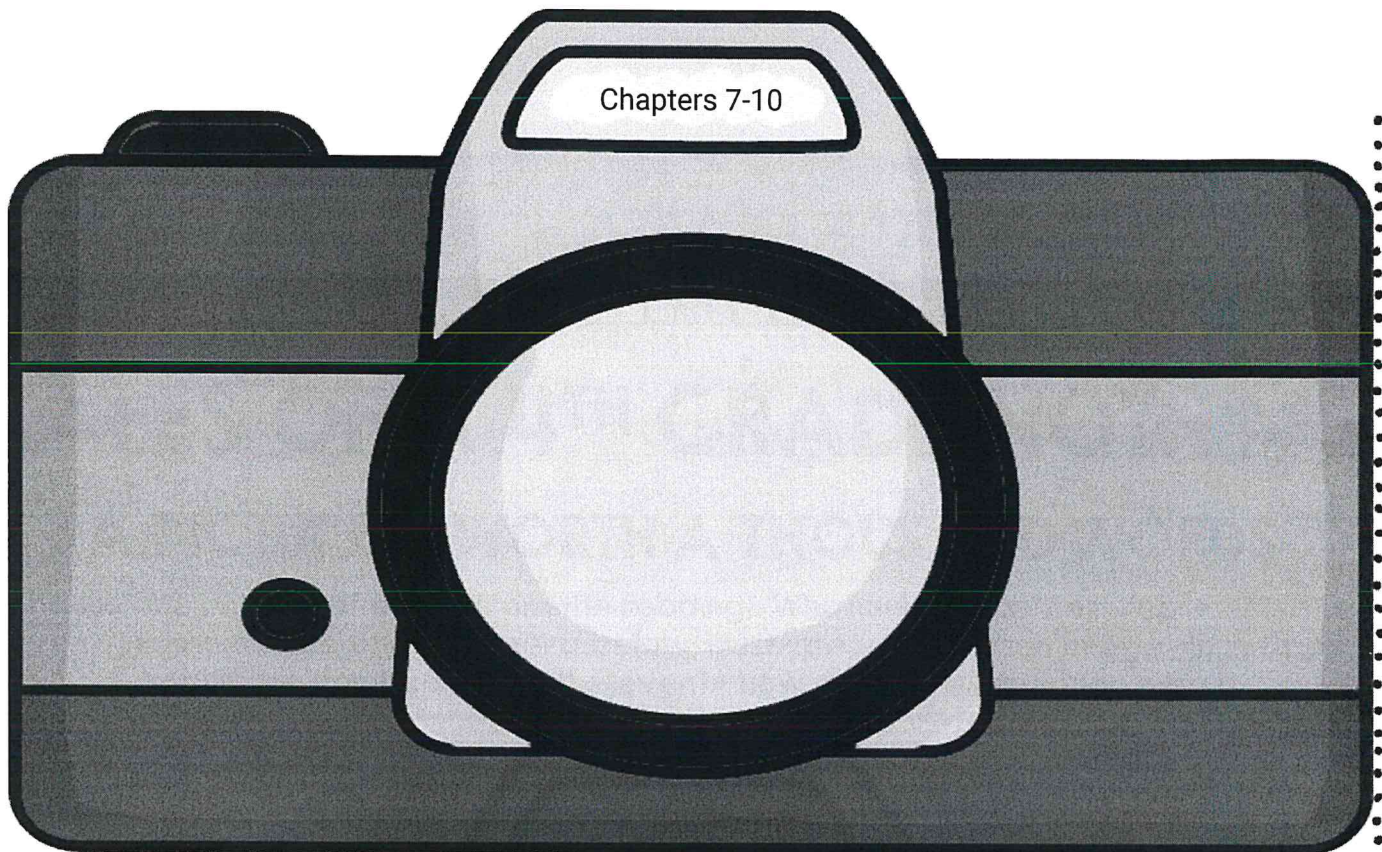
Chapters 4-6
