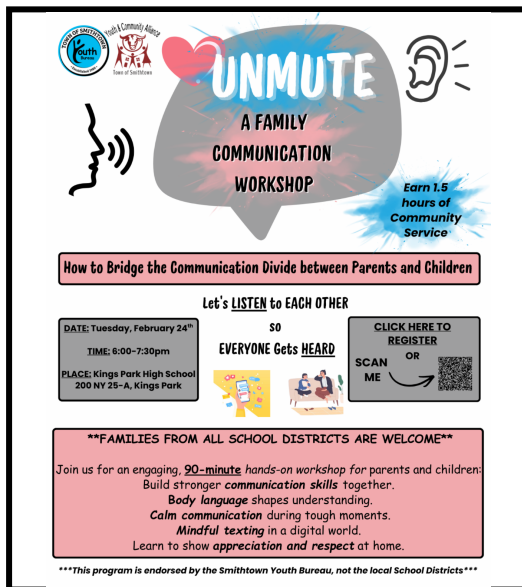

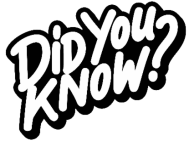
Black History Month
