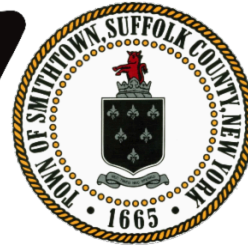

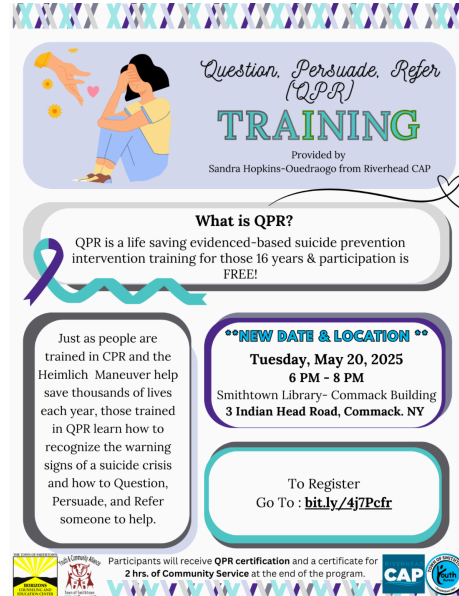
QPR Training

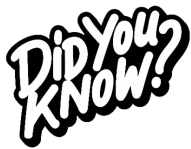
