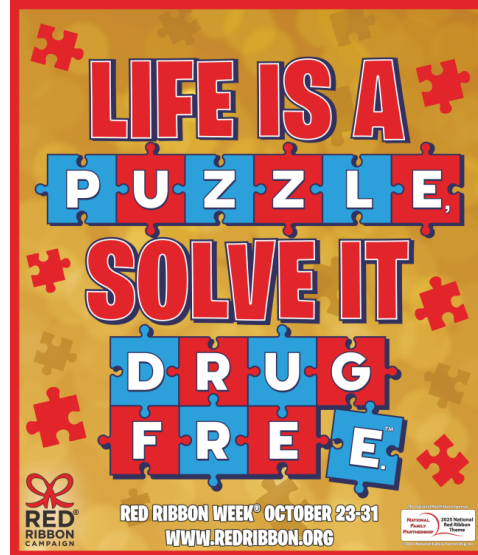
Red Ribbon Week

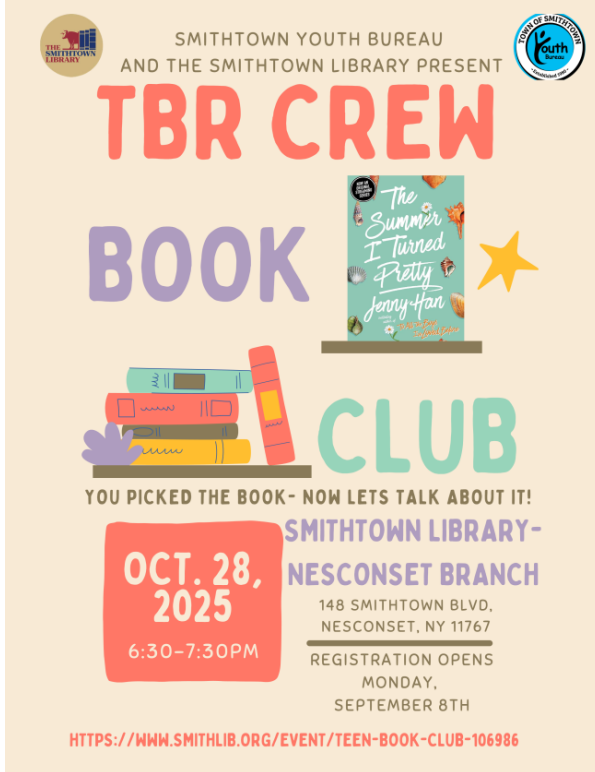
