**February 24 – What to Wear: Naturally Dyeing Fabrics Part 1**

What to Wear is a two-day activity that shows kids how colonists used natural materials to dye fabrics.

**March 3 – What to Wear: Naturally Dyeing Fabrics Part 2**

In the second part of the two-day activity, kids use their dry dyed cloth to create handmade dolls or handkerchiefs.

**March 10 – Mock Archaeological Dig** 

See if you can find artifacts such as musket balls and arrowheads in our mock dig site while understanding how real artifacts are discovered.

**March 17 – The History of Play *NEW!***

Discover the history of play by exploring and creating traditional colonial-era toys and games that children made and enjoyed in the past.
